







Statistically-Valid Survey

- Only scientific & defensible method to understand community needs
- Administered by mail/phone/web
- Developed in partnership with the staff
- Methodology allows high return rate (25%-35%)
- 325 surveys mailed
- 95% level of confidence with a margin of error of +/- 4.9%














City of Atlanta Recreation and Parks Needs Assessment Survey: Final Findings (2020)


